## **Checked Baggage Policies**



Below you will find a chart outlining the fees charge by certain airlines for checking baggage. Because of the numerous exemptions, it is not always easy to know when a checked bag fee may apply. As a result, you may want to include the following sample notice with your itineraries if space permits.

CHECKED BAGGAGE POLICIES VARY BY AIRLINE, FREQUENT FLYER STATUS, BOOKING CLASS, BAG SIZE AND WEIGHT. FEES MAY APPLY IF (1) YOU PLAN TO CHECK A BAG OR (2) YOU PLAN TO CARRY SPORTS EQUIPEMENT OR AN ODD-SHAPED ITEM OR (3) YOUR BAG EXCEEDS AIRLINE WEIGHT LIMITS.
